HOLIDAY DECORATING

We want all of our residents to enjoy living here and adding a personal touch by decorating for the holidays is one way to help make your house a home.

Any lights or decorations attached to the home must not cause any physical damage. Gutter clips or similar devices are required for affixing exterior lighting; nails, screws, etc. are prohibited. Roof decorations and lighting above the first floor roofline are not permitted. Resident will be required to immediately remove such decorations when discovered. Canned "snow" or other similar substances must not be sprayed on windows, siding or brick facades. Holiday lighting is only allowed from Thanksgiving until the second weekend in January, between 5PM and IOPM. Holiday lighting must be turned off when you are not home. Please remove lighting and holiday decoration by the weekend of January I3th.





OUTDOOR FAUCET COVERS

Winter weather and freezing temperatures will be here before we know it. Start getting your home ready for winter by disconnecting hoses and covering outside faucets with insulated covers. If you don't already have a faucet cover handy, come on down to the maintenance shop - we've got them for free! And, help ensure your furnace is operating at tip-top shape by replacing filters. Not only does replacing the filter help your furnace run more efficiently it can also help reduce maintenance issues. Free furnace filters are available at maintenance; give them a call for more details on winterizing.



RESIDENT ENERGY CONSERVATION PROGRAM (RECP)

Residents are charged the same rate that Hunt Military Communities is charged to provide utilities to your home.

- The rate will be included on billing statements and is available at any time by contacting Hunt Military Communities.
- The easiest way to reduce your energy usage is by regulating your thermostat to minimize heating and or cooling requirements. Wise use of hot water, lighting and appliances can also contribute significantly to energy savings.
- Residents with a past due account will receive delinquency notice letters and a late fee. Extreme delinquencies can result in a notice to vacate housing and can potentially affect your credit. Hunt Military Communities will work with you to arrange payment plans if you need help making payments.
