Acceptable Materials for Each of Your Carts

YES for recycling: #1 and #2 plastic bottles, junk mail, phone books, magazines, newspapers, computer paper, tin and aluminum cans.

NO for recycling: plastic bags, plastic wrap, Styrofoam, tetra pack milk or juice cartons, butter tubs, wrapping paper, packing peanuts, car parts, animal waste, dirty diapers and motor oil containers. **No Food Waste or Clothing.**

YES for garbage: basic household items that cannot go into recycling.

NO garbage: hazardous materials such as fertilizers or pesticides, bulky objects (furniture or appliances), liquid waste (oil or paint), construction materials, soil, sod, rocks, steel or wood. **No Glass** - take to provided glass bins!!

Holiday Schedule
