Due to safety concerns, and the mid-summer burn ban, fireworks are not allowed in base housing and common areas. As stated in your community handbook:

The manufacturing, sale, storage, possession, transporting and/ or use of fireworks and all incendiary devices are expressly prohibited on the premises or in the neighborhood. Violation of the

Reception Devices Home Security Systems & Satellite Dishes

In accordance with the Constitution Park Community Handbook (page 8, section 4) Below are a few things you need to know before installing a reception device within Navy Housing.

- Residents are financially responsible for all costs in-• curred for installation of cable TV and/or Internet service or connections.
- Additionally, all costs for service are payable by the Resident. The names of the cable companies serving the Neighborhood will be provided at move-in. Prior written approval is required from the NMO for installation of additional hook-ups. Request forms are available from the NMO.
- The Reception Device cannot be mounted on the side of a building. If the Reception Device is mounted in an impermissible location, Owner may require that Resident, at Resident's expense, remove the Reception Device at any time. Resident may not damage or alter the Premises to install the Reception Device or to connect to wiring and equipment. No holes whatsoever may be drilled through outside walls, firewalls, glass, windows, roofs, balconies, balcony railings, or through anything else. No holes may be drilled through walls or anything else to bring in wires.
- You must notify the leasing office no later than thirty (30) days after installation, permit an inspection, and sign a Reception Device Addendum to the Lease Agreement.
- The reception device must be removed by the household on or before the date the household vacates the home.

For the complete list of things to know, It is strongly recommended to refer to the Constitution Park Community Handbook and Reception Device Addendum.
