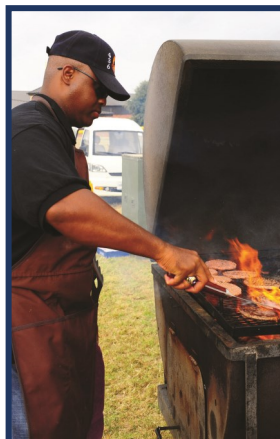
Oak Harbor's Old Fashion 4th of July Parade

BBQ Safety

Summer is grillin' season and we want to help ensure everyone is doing all they can to grill safely... Never operate your grill closer than 10 feet from your home, wooden fence or overhanging branches. Cooking food in the front yard or covered balconies/patios is prohibited. Store propane tanks safely and inspect them often for signs of damage or rust. Never leave your grill unattended while in use. **If using charcoal, make sure coals are completely cold to the touch before discarding.** As a reminder: **tiki torches** and **fire pits** are not permitted anywhere in the housing areas.
