On September 19th, residents took the opportunity to participate in our 'Make & Sip' Craft event. This event allowed residents





Surge Protector Safety

Safeguard electronics with surge protectors. Follow these tips to keep you and your electronics safe. Only use surge protectors with internal circuit breakers. These units will trip the breaker if the power strip is overloaded to prevent overheating. Here are some electrical tips in keeping your home and family safe:

- Don't use surge protectors as permanent wir-
- Unplug the surge protector when not in use.
- Don't plug a surge protector into an existing surge protector or power strip.
- Replace your surge protector if it is hot to the touch, has frayed wires, or is not working properly.
- Be sure that the UL-listed product is a transient voltage surge suppressor.
